#### Last 5 Years – Construction Dollars

- Construction Dollars Spent (not including MILCON)
  - 136 Contract Actions (Awards & Mods)
  - Totaling ~\$19M
  - Represents 22% of Actions & 67% of Dollars




## Small Business Policy

• It is the policy of the Government to provide **maximum practicable opportunities in its acquisitions** to small business, veteran-owned small business, service-disabled veteran-owned small business, HUBZone small business, small disadvantaged business, and women-owned small business concerns.

Reference: 48 CFR 19.201







#### What is a Small Business?

- How does the government categorize a company as a "Small Business"
  - Depends on the Size of the company and what the company sells
  - Must go through the Registration Process (more on this later)
    - Who can help??
      - MN PTAC
      - SBA

# U.S. AIR FORCE

#### Small Business Set-Asides

- Above \$10,000 and under \$250,000
  - Automatically reserved for small business UNLESS
    - Contracting Officer determines that there is no reasonable expectation that can
      - Obtain offers from two or more responsible SB concerns that are competitive in terms of market price, quality, and delivery (Rule of Two)
    - Only one offer rec'd from responsible SB
      - Award made to that firm
- NOTE:
  - Micro Purchase Threshold = \$10,000
  - Simplified Acquisition Threshold = \$250,000



## Small Business Consideration (over \$250K)

- CO set aside any acquisition over \$250K for SB participation when reasonable expectation that:
  - (1) offers will be obtained from at least two responsible SB concerns...and
  - (2) award will be made at fair market prices
- Relationship among SB programs >\$250K
  - First consider HUBZone, 8(a), SDVOSB, WOSB, EDWOSB
     set-asides
     Parity among these
  - Then, SB set-aside
  - Finally, full and open competition



#### Last 5 Years SB Dollars

- Total SB Eligible Dollars ~\$26M
- Small Business 96.5% / ~\$25M
- Small Disadvantaged Business 35.7% / ~\$9M
- 8(a) 5.9% / ~\$1.5M
- Veteran Owned SB 25.6% / ~\$7.4M
- Service Disabled VOSB 21.5% / ~\$5.5M
- Woman Owned SB 15.5% / ~\$4M
- Certified HUBZone 0.2%% / ~\$64K



# Types of Solicitations




- Invitation for Bid
  - Sealed Bid DO NOT BE LATE
  - Non-complex construction
  - Awarded based on Lowest Price
- Request for Quote / Request for Proposal
  - RFQs Under \$250,000 / RFPs Over \$250,000
  - Submit Proposal or Quote
    - IAW instructions in solicitation
  - Awarded
    - based on evaluation criteria specified in solicitation
      - Technical, Price, Past Performance

# 934th Contracting Flight Public Website





- System for Award Management (<u>www.sam.gov</u>)
  - Official Website of the US Government (USG)
  - No cost to use SAM
  - FREE
    - Register to business with USG
    - Update or renew registration (required annually)
    - Check status of registration
    - Search for companies (entities) registered and exclusion records

ANYONE DOING BUSINESS WITH THE USG MUST HAVE AN ACTIVE REGISTRATION IN SAM

    - North American Industry Classification System
  - Ensure the NAICS listed in the solicitation is one that is listed in your company's SAM registration
- Set up notifications in FedBizOpps so are notified of opportunities that satisfy the parameters you set up
  - E.g. all 934<sup>th</sup> AW opportunities
- Update DSBS profile

## **Brief Government Funding Information**



- Facility Sustainment Restoration and Modernization (FSRM)
   Program
  - Projects id'd at Base Level and Approved at Higher HQ
  - Operations & Maintenance Funds
    - Are Obligated at end of each FY 30 Sep midnight
    - Funds flow to 934<sup>th</sup> AW from Higher HQ (AFRC)
  - Statutory Limit of \$2M
  - Design is funded and approved separately
    - Architect-Engineering contracts
  - Construction (once Design complete) is funded and approved based on priority to 934<sup>th</sup> AW and HQ AFRC
    - Advanced Contracting Authority to Solicit
    - Fund and Award



# Advanced Contracting Authority

- Included in solicitation --
  - "Notice to Offeror(s)/Supplier(s): Funds are not presently available for this effort. No award will be made under this solicitation until funds are available. The Government reserves the right to cancel this solicitation, either before or after the closing date. In the event the Government cancels this solicitation, the Government has no obligation to reimburse an offeror for any costs."
  - Bids/Quotes/Proposal acceptance period through 9/30





- Military Construction (MILCON)
  - Exceed \$2M
  - Different approval process than O&M funds used by the FSRM projects
    - Can take longer... why??
      - Requires an authorization and separate appropriation for each construction project
  - For AF Executed by the Army Corps of Engineers
  - MILCON Funds Last 5 years
